REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- 1. Must be a DuPage County resident.**
- 2. Must verify citizenship/residency status.**
- 3. Must be eligible to earn taxable wages.**
- 4. Must have own transportation.**

ESLP APPLICATION CHECKLIST

You must do as indicated below before you can start the ESL program.

- 1. Attend an informational meeting.**
- 2. Complete ESLP application during the informational meeting.
(Parent signature required if under 18)**
- 3. Schedule an applicant interview after collecting all required documentation.**
- 4. Take the TEST OF ADULT BASIC EDUCATION.**
- 5. Applicants will be notified by ESLP staff of acceptance into the program.**
